

James Sellers and Charity and Mystery James Sellerses

Children:

Cain d. 1826 Roane Co TN, wrote Will mentioning siblings

Sarah b. 1782 Family bible not mentioned in Will

William b. 1780-90 Rhea Co TN Census 1830

Eunice Pearson b. 1784 Family bible

Micah b. 1786 Family bible

Mary Thompson b. 1787 Family bible

James

John

Isaiah b. 1796 Family history

(Sampson) mentioned in Cain's will but not as brother

Bible only mentions Sarah, Eunice Micah & Mary and Will does not mention Sarah. Sarah perhaps deceased by 1826. There could be other children also possibly deceased by 1826.

Possible Census profile 1800:

2 -4 m < 10; 1 -3 m 10-15; 1-2 m 16-25; 1 m 26-44 or 45+

1-2 f 10-15; 1 f 16-25; 1 f 26-44 or 45+

There has to be 1 m < 10 (Isaiah); 1 m 10-15 (Micah) and James and John would be <10 or 10-15) and 1 f 10-15 (Mary) & should be 1 -2 f 16-25 (Eunice and Sarah; Eunice could be 10-15)

1800 Census Burke Co NC

James Sellers same page as Scott

4 m <10; 2m 10-15; 1 m 16-25; 1 m 45+

2 f 10-15; 1 f 16-25; 1 f 26-44

This is likely the family: (Sampson), Isaiah, John & James<10; Micah & William 10-15; Cain 16-25; Mary & Eunice 10-15; Sarah 16-25

James Sellers on same page as Robert Sellers

2 m<10; 1 m 10-15; 1 m 26-44

4 f<10; 2 f 10-15; 1 f 26-44

Does not fit; could be family of James of Stono Creek; family gone in 1810.

Possible Census profile 1810:

1-3 m 10-15; 1-3 m 16-25; 1 m 26-44; daughters may not be there; there should be some of these younger males

1810 Census Burke Co NC

James Sellers

4 m 10-15; 1 m 16-25; 1 m 45+

1 f 10-15; 1 f 45+

(Sampson), Isaiah, John and James? 10-15; Micah 16-25

Who's the female 10-15? She was not in household in 1800. Still, this is likely the family of James and Charity and girl may be a relation they took in.

James Sellers

4 m 10-15; 1 m 16-25

3 f <10; 1 f 16-25

Looks like a family of orphans. The girls could be James' Who does James belong to? There are too many males age

10-15 to be part of family of unidentified James Sellers in Burke 1800.

Possible Census profile 1820:

Not necessarily any children left at home.

Charity Sellers

1 m 16-18; 1 m 16-26; 1 f 45+

Who's the male 16-18? All of the males should be over 20 by 1820. Male 16-26, likely Isaiah.

James Sellers' estate probated 1820; wife Charity and Isaiah Sellers, exrs.

Mystery James Sellers

1800 Chatham Co NC

James Sellers

1 m 16-25; 1 m 45+; 1 f 45+ (Census is a mess to read)

This is supposedly James (Valentine mark, aka T/Y) Sellers

James is said to have had son James b. abt 1756, md. abt 1774 to UNK and 2nd to Sarah UNK Booker (Georgia's acct)

James Sellers

1 m 16-25 and 1 f 16-25

So this is not James Jr. of James but maybe grandson?

Where is James Jr. ?

Was James Jr. perhaps in Burke Co NC, in 1800?

1810 Chatham Co NC

I find no James Sellers or any Sellers family in Chatham Co NC. Seems they moved to what became Maury Co TN, where a James Sellars was among petitioners to form Maury Co TN.

Conclusion: Mystery James of 1800 Burke Co. NC could either be James of Stono Creek or James Jr. of James of Chatham.
